# Information Brochure

*The Institute : The Indian Institute of Materials Management. IIMM emerged as an All India Body in 1975 with the merger of three professional associations. The National Association of Materials Management which until 1966 was known as National Association of Purchasing Executives, The Materials Management Association of India earlier known as Purchasing Officers' Association and the Materials Management Association of Hyderabad, and was named as the Indian Association of Materials Management (IAMM) which was latter changed of Indian Institute of Materials Management (IIMM). This merger was in itself a milestone, thus given birth to an Institute in its present form, India's only professionally recognized body for Materials Management.*

*The Profession : The Institute through its membership and regional branches all over the country, represents a wide spectrum of professionals engaged in the various facets of Materials Management and responsible for the planning of acquisition, control and distribution of materials and services. The need, to introduce and implement modern tools and techniques of Materials Management, is widely recognized in Public, Private and Government sectors.*

### *Objectives :*

- *To secure a wider recognition of and promote the importance of efficient Materials Management in commercial and Industrial undertakings.*
- *To safeguard and elevate the professional status of individuals engaged in the Materials Management faculty.*
- *To constantly impart advanced professional knowledge and thus improve the skill of the person engaged in the Materials Management function.*
- *Propagate and promote among the members strict adherence to IIMM Code of Conduct and Ethics*

### *Code of Ethics :*

- *To consider first, the TOTAL interest to one's organization in all transactions without impairing the dignity and responsibility to one's office;*

## *International Affiliation*

*The Institute is a charter member of the International Federation of Supply Management (IFPSM) which has its headquarters in USA. The IFPSM was founded in 1974 with the merger of International Committee of Purchasing and European Federation of Purchasing. It represents a world wide unity of purchasing, materials management and logistics professionals. It has more than 1,50,000 members through its members associations in 38 countries spread over 6 continents. IFPSM enjoys, a consultative status with the United National Economic and Trade Development (UNCTAD) and the United Nations Economics and Social Council (ECOSOC).*

*IIMM has hosted the prestigious IFPSM World Congress in Mumbai in November 1993.*

## *Governing Body*

*National Council : The National Council whose members are elected, consists of the President, Senior Vice President, Five Regional Vice Presidents, National Secretary/Treasurer and National Council Members representing individual Branches.*

*Branch Committee : Each branch is governed through elected Members consisting of Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, Committee Members and National Council Members.*

## *Activities :*

*The Institute is also conducting a Graduate Diploma Course in Materials Management (GDMM) which has been recognized by Govt. of India for appointment of superior posts and services under the Central Government and also accredited by IFPSM.. It also conducts a three years Post Graduate Diploma Course in Materials Management (PGDMM) by correspondence, which is approved by AICTE, and Post Graduate Diploma in Logistics Management – 1 year by Distance Education. IIMM also conducts Certified Purchasing Manager (C.P.M), courses from Institute for Supply Management (ISM), USA and International Purchasing & Supply Chain Management (IPSM) from ITC-(WTO/UNCTAD), Geneva. It also conducts MBA in Material Management (in association with MP (Bhoj) open University, Bhopal, M.P.*

*The above courses are controlled at the National level by a Board of Studies consisting of leading personalities from academic and professional field. The faculties are drawn from experts in Industry, Educational/Professional Institutions in the country.*

*Others : Today IIMM has 38 branches and 18 chapters all over India. It has over 8000 Individual and Institutional members, drawn from public, private & government sectors. The Branches conducts various programmes for the benefit of the members.*

*In order to propagate the profession of Materials Management, the Institute also arranges a National Convention every year, in one of the major cities in India. The Institute regularly organizes Executive Development Programmes to upgrade the knowledge of practicing managers. For the Conventions and EDP's the members are given liberal concessions in Registration fees.*

*The Institute organizes a prestigious **All India Young Materials Managers** competition encouraging the young materials professionals. **The National Award**, the highest honour of the Institute is conferred with the objective of giving recognition to one of its members for outstanding contribution to the development of the profession and the Institute.*

*The Institute celebrates **April 23<sup>rd</sup> as Materials Management day** each year as it was rechristened as IIMM on this day.*

### *Centre for Research in Materials Management (CRIMM)*

*IIMM has set up CRIMM in Kolkata jointly with the Indian Institute of Social Welfare and Business Management (IISWBM). An MOU was signed with IISWBM as early as 17<sup>th</sup> February 1997. IISWBM is the first Management Institute in India, setup in 1953 and inaugurated by Pt. J.L. Nehru, the then Prime Minister of India. CRIMM was officially inaugurated on April 04, 1997 at Kolkata.*

### *Publication*

*IIMM has its own in house journal called "Materials Management Review", covering various aspects of Materials Management, its modern trends and research activities. It is published on monthly basis and is distributed to all the members.*

### *Chartership*

*The Institute is vigorously following up with the Central Government for Chartership to the Materials Management profession. The Chartership will confer upon the Institute the status of an Institution set up by an act of Parliament*

### *Membership*

*Fellow Member : (Entrance Fees : ₹. 500/- Annual Subscription ₹. 1000/-)*

- ★ Any person with a senior status in the field of Materials Management for a period of atleast 15 years, shall be considered eligible for membership.*
- ★ He shall not be less than 40 years of age at the time of admission.*
- ★ He shall hold a university degree or Diploma or have attended a recognized course in Materials Management.  
(Please obtain separate membership form)*

*Member : (Entrance Fees : ₹. 500/- Annual Subscription ₹. 500/-)*

- ★ Any person working in the field of Materials Management or*
- ★ He shall not be less than 23 years of age at the time of admission*
- ★ He shall hold a University degree in any discipline or Diploma in Engineering or has passed a Course in Materials Management approved by the Institute.*

*Associate Member : (Entrance Fees : Rs. 500/- Annual Subscription Rs. 400/-)*

- ★ *Any person engaged in Materials Management activities for a minimum of one year, and*
- ★ *He shall not be less than 18 years of age at the time of admission.*
- ★ *He shall hold a University degree in any discipline or Diploma in Engineering or has passed a Course in Materials Management.*

### *Institutional Member*

*Large Scale (Entrance Fees : Rs. 1000/- Annual Subscription Rs. 5000/-) (w.e.f. 1.12.06)*

- ★ *Any firm which holds registration with Directorate General of Technical Development or holds a license or approval under the Industries Development & Regulation Act, shall be governed under this category. The Institution shall be eligible to nominate two persons from their organization.*

*Small Scale : (Entrance Fees : Rs. 500/- Annual Subscription Rs. 2000/-) (w.e.f. 1.12.06)*

- ★ *Any firm, which holds a registration with local Directorate of Industries or any other approval authority shall be governed under this category. This Institution shall be eligible to nominate one person from their organization.*

*Life Member :*

- ★ *Already enrolled members, who have paid annual subscription upto date, can become life members by paying Rs. 7500/- as one time payment. A new applicant has to pay the entrance fees (Rs. 500/- + Rs. 7500/-). (w.e.f. 1.12.06) (one time payment)*

*Life Fellow Member :*

- ★ *A person who is a life member can become a Life fellow member by paying 10000 as additional one time payment.*

*A fellow member who has paid annual subscription upto date can become a life fellow members by paying Rs. 15000 as one time payment.(from 1<sup>st</sup> Dec. 2006) - (w.e.f. 1.12.06)*

*Application Procedure : Application for membership shall be made on prescribed application form available with the nearest branch or Indian Institute of Materials Management*
